# **Daily Market Update**

The market closed in red today. The benchmark index DSEX (-1.18%) lost 65.1 points and closed at 5,473.15. The blue-chip index DS30 (-1.06%), the Shariah-based index DSES (-1.31%), and the large-cap index CDSET (-0.80%) closed at 2,129.90, 1,188.23, and 1,108.86 points, respectively. All the large-cap Allied (-0.71%), Pharmaceutical (-0.51%), and Bank (-0.45%), respectively. Block trades contributed 4.0% of the overall market turnover. Robi Axiata PLC (-4.1%) was the most traded share with a turnover of BDT 424 million.




