
Market closed in green

Daily Market Update

The market closed in green today. The benchmark index DSEX (+1.50%) gained 84.7 points and closed at 5,718.75. The blue-chip index DS30 (+2.75%), the Shariahbased index DSES (+1.84%), and the large-cap index CDSET (+2.31%) closed at 2,123.97, 1,297.41, and 1,212.87 points, respectively. All the large-cap sectors posted positive performance today except Bank (-1.43%) and NBFI (-0.52%). Telecommunication booked the highest gain of 3.20% followed by Fuel & Power (+2.54%), Pharmaceutical (+2.33%), Food & Allied (+1.46%), and (+1.31%), respectively. Block trades contributed 3.6% of the overall market turnover. Bangladesh Export Import Company Ltd. (+10.0%) was the most traded share with a turnover of BDT 1,653 million.



Important DSE News

CONFIDCEM

The Board of Directors has recommended 15% cash and 5% stock dividend for the year ended on June 30, 2020. Date of AGM: 28.02.2021, Time: 11:00 AM, Venue: Digital Platform, Record Date: 31.01. 2021. The Company has reported consolidated EPS of Tk. 8.30, Consolidated NAV per share of Tk. 66.73 and Consolidated NOCFPS of Tk. 10.87 for the year ended on June 30, 2020 as against Tk. 6.76, Tk. 68.51 and Tk. 0.34 respectively for the same period of the previous year. The Company has also informed that i) Bonus Shares have been recommended in view of utilizing its retained amount as capital to continue investment to 5.6 MW Captive Power Plant and factory premises. ii) Bonus shares is declared out of accumulated profit. iii) Bonus shares is not declared from capital reserve or revaluation reserve or any unrealized gain or out of profit earned prior to incorporation of the company or through reducing paid up capital or through doing anything so that the post-dividend retained earnings become negative or a debit balance.

(Q1 Un-audited): Consolidated EPS was Tk. 3.88 for July-September 2020 as against Tk. 2.51 for July-September 2019; Consolidated NOCFPS was Tk. 0.35 for July-September 2020 as against Tk. (2.74) July-September 2019. Consolidated NAV per share was Tk. 70.65 as on September 30, 2020 and Tk. 66,73 as on June 30, 2020.

DSENEWS: The maintenance work of DSEs Order Management System (OMS) will be started immediately and shall be continued for next 3 weeks to improve its performance. As such, the DSE mobile app trading service will be available to the users from 10:15 AM to 2:00 PM only during the period from Monday, January 11, 2021 to Monday, February 1, 2021. After that the DSE mobile app service will be available for all sessions and full trading hours i.e. from 9:45 AM to 2:40 PM.

AZIZPIPES

The Company has informed that the Board of Directors has decided following decision: due to COVID-19 pandemic, PVC resin (the main raw material) use in production was not delivered on time by the supplier and for lack of stocks of PVC resin sudden hampers production activities. Due to abnormal increase in the price of raw materials in the local market, the price of production will be much higher than the current market price. As a result, the Company will suffer in marketing the produced product. In this circumstances, production of the Company temporarily stopped from C-shift on January 10, 2021. Production activities will resume once the supply of PVC resin improves and the situation improves.

Mr. Md. Ashraf Ali Khan, one of the Sponsors of BBS Cables Limited, has reported his intention to sell 32,00,900 shares out of his total holding of 64,00,900 whereas Mr. Md.
