BSEC fines Aftab Automobiles and Genex Infosys Tk1.43cr over unsettled dividends

The Bangladesh Securities and Exchange Commission (BSEC) has slapped a combined fine of Tk1.43 crore on directors and senior officials of Aftab Automobiles Ltd and Genex Infosys PLC for failing to distribute declared cash dividends to shareholders within the stipulated timeframe.

Power Grid gets BSEC nod to issue Tk1,529cr preference shares to govt

BSEC gave its consent to issue 152.92 crore preference shares at a face value of Tk10 each. PGCB received a substantial amount of funds from the government in FY2024–25, against which it will now issue preference shares. Power Grid had previously issued preference shares to the government worth Tk10,146 crore in several tranches. PGCB's outstanding share money deposits stood at Tk3,376 crore at the end of March 2026.
